2. **By post or e-mail:** Complete the application on the voting notification and send it back,
or send an e-mail to wahlen@offenbach.de.
3. **In person at the Citizens' Office (Kaiserstraße 39):**
Bring your ID card, take a ticket, receive your documents – and, if you wish,
vote directly on site.
